Brighton Street Early Learning is committed to preventing child abuse and identifying risks early, and removing and reducing these risks.

Brighton Street Early Learning has strict procedures of recruitment practises for all staff and volunteers.

Brighton Street Early Learning support and respect all children, as well as our staff and volunteers. We are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, the cultural safety of children from a culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds, and to providing a safe environment for children with a disability.
